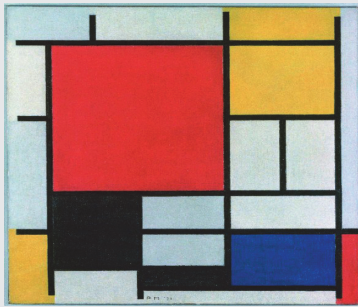

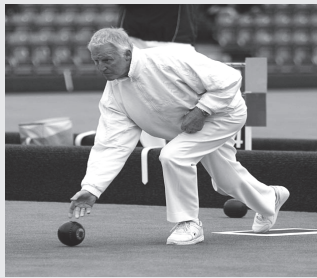

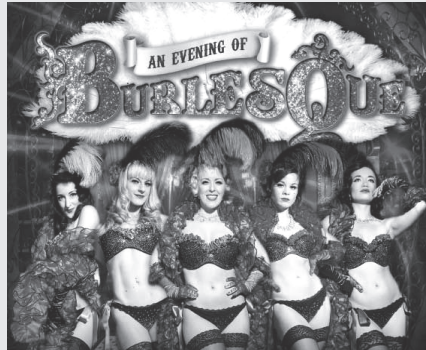

Mondrian and Colour

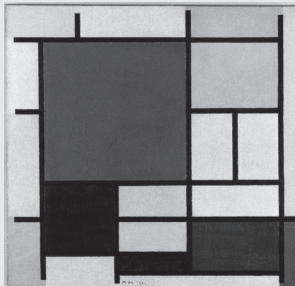
Exhibitions - Turner Contemporary

Spencer Finch

'Piet Mondrian changed painting. The twentieth century Dutch artist moved from depicting reality to pioneer something completely new and controversial, abstraction.

His most famous works, the 'grids' use simple lines and the primary colours red, yellow and blue to create a 'universal harmony', separating colour and subject from reality, transforming the material world into something spiritual.

70 years after Mondrian's death, get beneath the grid and trace Mondrian's journey to abstraction through colour. Colour underpinned Mondrian's work, from the early days painting landscapes in the Netherlands, to the later works where colour was separated from its function of creating shading or volume.'

Turner Contemporary presents a major exhibition of work by American artist **Spencer Finch**. Finch's first solo exhibition in an English public gallery in over 5 years brings together new and recent works by the artist, all of which reflect on the changing coastal light of Margate and other sites. The exhibition will be accompanied by a group of JMW Turner's watercolours selected by Finch from the Tate collection.

Spencer Finch the exhibition includes a large-scale suspended 'cloud' sculpture, made from simple translucent filters that subtly alter its transparency and opacity as the natural light in the space changes throughout the day, recreating the effect of a passing cloud.

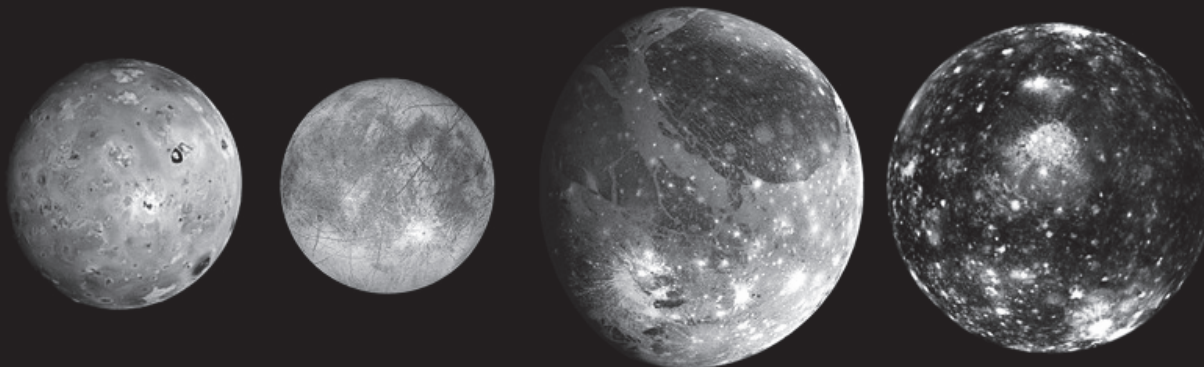

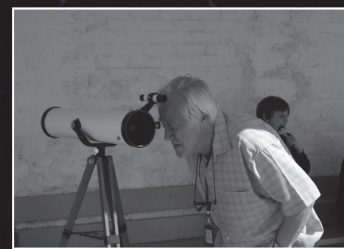
Night Viewing

What time of night ?

In the winter (GMT) it gets dark about 4pm in the afternoon but in summer (BST) it doesn't get dark till around 10:30pm. This means that in the winter we can run early evening Night Viewing Sessions that are suitable for families with children although it can be cold so wrap up warm In the Summer, Night Viewing can't start until about 10pm at the earliest, it is of course much warmer, but the late time is more suited to adults rather than children.

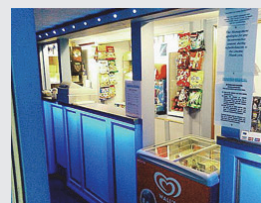

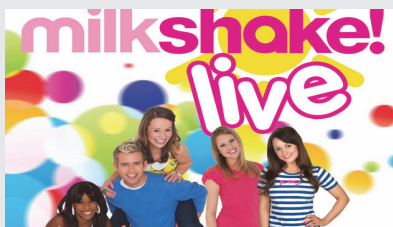
